

Dear parents

The teaching staff have been doing some excellent professional learning on Wednesday mornings around what it means to be a Christian school in the 21st century. There are many secular ideas challenging a Biblical worldview and if there ever was a time to guard our faith and teach our young people to be truth keepers it is now. Absolutes are counter cultural and those who hold to them are sometimes regarded as extremists. Truth is sometimes labelled as hate speech. Schools are becoming increasingly open to a range of spiritual ideas and practices and students are taught that truth can be different for different people. A range of life styles are celebrated and what is right is called good and what is good is called evil. A Christian school needs to be a distinctive community of love and truth where God's word is truth and young people are transformed into image bearers. Where the world is seen not as a resource but as a gift given

from God to be cared for, where students are seen as image bearers, creative, rational, relational beings and diversity in cultures celebrated as a taste of Heaven where all people from every tribe, tongue and nation will be gathered before Him in worship. Teaching and learning in a Christian school aims to be integrated, reflecting wholeness of creation. It deals with real life problems, reflecting God's mandate to be stewards of creation. It sets meaningful goals, reflecting God's purposes for His image-bearers to display His character. And it is about gaining wisdom as well as knowledge, reflecting God's desire for discernment, thoughtful action and the service of others. We, as a staff at Jireh, seek to serve our God and your children in carrying out this mandate and as partners with you in educating your children. I would like to thank those who pray for us and the school community as our success is built on the wings of prayer.

It gives me great delight to introduce four new parent representatives to our

Establishment Board of Trustees. We welcome Lindsay Steele, Madeleine Ploeg, Michael Causley and Dianne Thompson who have been co-opted onto the Board until we have the opportunity to hold our first Board of Trustees election. This will take place in unison with the national cycle in Term 2 next year.


