We will be holding a Day of Delight where students' art will be on display. Poetry and music recitals will be performed, whilst enjoying a delicious high tea. The Year 8 graduation dinner will be a special time to celebrate our Senior students' primary years and send them off with a blessing to the next phase of their learning journey. There will be one more Mufti Day to raise funds for our TEAR Fund sponsor child, Benimana, in Rwanda. We will continue with special lunch opportunities through Lunch On Line, (Pita Pit) and Chicken Madness. Swimming and athletic skills will be the focus for sport. 
