







Teaching Staff = 9 full time, 4 part time. Support Staff = 12 (job share roles). Jireh Christian School officially opened on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2018. Two Christian Schools; Jireh School and Immanuel Christian School, came together to form Jireh Christian School.

#### **FACILITIES:**

The school has 10 classrooms and 1 withdrawal room. There is a science laboratory, library, art, ESOL (English as Second Language), PMP (Perceptual Motion Programme), and music rooms. There is also a Board room, office block, sick bay, field, sports sheds, changing rooms and three playgrounds. The facilities include the use of a full-sized hall.
